Approval to submit a proposal

ITEM SUMMARY: (PLEASE DISCUSS THIS ITEM)

Berkeley City College with the Peralta Community College District is planning to submit a Teacher Preparation Pipeline CTE grant to the California Community College Chancellor's Office. TPP grants are designed to help address the anticipated shortage of secondary and community college Career Technical Education (CTE) teachers. Grant recipients, in conjunction with high schools and BA granting institutions, will identify, recruit, enroll, and retain students in courses designed to provide a pathway leading to a teaching career in a CTE field.

This grant will provide between 100,000 and 225,000 to establish partnerships, develop curriculum, and recruit students to either become or to enter into a training pathway to become a CTE instructor at a secondary or post-secondary institution. This is a one year grant, and it allows for creation of pathways to serve two primary populations: 1) students in grades 10 to 14 (high school or community college) who may be interested in continuing on to a 4 year college to obtain a credential in a CTE field; or 2) Technical professionals in a CTE field who may be interested in teaching at a Community or Technical College. Funding amount is up to \$225,000. The chancellor recommends approval. Funding Agency: State Chancellor's Office, Sacramento
