Overview of the 4 standards

Standard I

Institutional Mission and Effectiveness

This standard reviews the **Mission and values of each college**, and looks at how it addresses **institutional effectiveness**. The visiting team is looking to see that the institution maintains an ongoing collegial, self-reflective dialogue about the continuous improvement of student learning and institutional processes.

In addition this standard looks at the mission of the college and that the college is communicating the mission internally and externally. The team is looking to verify that the institution has a statement of mission that defines the institution's broad educational purposes, its intended student population, and its commitment to achieving student learning

Student Learning Programs and Services

This is the section where we discuss Instructional Student Learning Outcomes (SLO's)

IIB

Identifies **Student Learning Programs and Services** such as EOPS, CAL Works, DSPS, PUENTE, and Counseling Services etc.... SLO's for student services are addressed here.
