






## International/Non-Resident Tuition Revenue

- The Office of International Affairs has generated over **\$5.8 million**. This is an increase of **\$2.3 million** since last year.
- The total revenue generated since its inception in 1997 has been **\$34.7 million**.

# Distance Education

- **\$4.6 million** has been generated from the District's Distance Education program. There were **1013 FTES** for the last fiscal year.

# Distance Education cont.

- **Separate budget needed** to provide necessary support services for Distance Education
  
- **Faculty and Technical Support** needed for the following:
  - Cyber-Advising/Tutoring
  - Online Assessment Tests/Proctoring
  - Instructional Technology/Moodle System
  - Online Syllabi and Teaching Materials
  - Student Inquiries
  - Online Enrollment Support
  - Authentication

# Distance Education cont.

- **Alternative mode of distance or electronic delivery**, which is saving resources and breaking boundaries:
  - Reduces maintenance services (Custodial)
  - Helps with space problems in classrooms
  - Serves students with transportation issues
  - Reduces spending on utilities and facilities
  - Promotes healthy environment and conserves natural resources

# President Obama's \$12 billion community college plan

- July 14, 2009 –
- **\$500 million** would be used to develop online courses and materials to improve student learning, including artificial intelligence tutoring and multimedia courses.

# Accreditation

- **The following Substantive Change action approved by the Committee on Substantive Change was ratified by the Commission at the June 9-11 meeting.**
- **Berkeley City College:**
  - To add **five Associate of Arts degrees** and **three certificates**
  - 50% or more offered through a mode of distance or electronic delivery.
  - The **degrees** are in Liberal Arts, with emphasis Arts and Humanities, Social and Behavioral Sciences; English Language and Literature; Global Studies, and Spanish.
  - The **certificates** are in the Liberal Arts CSU General Education Breadth Certificate of Achievement; Liberal Arts Intersegmental General Education Transfer Certificate of Achievement and Spanish Certificate of Achievement. (Approved 5/15/09)
