Outcomes from meeting on Sept. 3, 2009**

**The Health Services Steering Committee met to discuss the following:**

- Release of Request for Interest (RFI).

There was a discussion on the Request for Interest (RFI). The intent of the RFI is to seek qualified vendors to become the designated PCCD health center lead agency and deliver comprehensive health programming for Peralta students. The committee reached agreement that the RFI process should move forward after the final review on Sept. 8, 2009.

- Levy the Health Fee.

The implementation of a health fee was discussed. The committee agreed that the \$17.00 per semester health fee should be assessed no later than January 2010.

- Get started on choosing a location and building the facility.

There was a discussion on the need to designate a facilities lead from PCCD to serve on this committee.

**The next steps approved by the committee:**

- Agreement on RFI process after final review on Sept. 8.
- Peralta to move \$35,000 to Health Care Services Agency (HCSA), to be matched by HCSA, for a contractor to lead the design and development of the Health Initiative.
- Jim Bracy will contact Vice Chancellor Sadiq Ikharo to identify a facilities lead to support the facilities and planning phase of the project.

## **EasyPass Update**

9/10/09

**Eligibility** – 14,487 students are enrolled in 9 or more units.

**Production** – 8,652 bus passes have been produced.

**Reactivation** – 1,213 students from Spring '09 have reactivated their bus passes.

**Payment** – 4,145 students have paid for their EasyPass.

Turn around time for issuing bus passes

- a. same day for students in initial production run
- b. five working days for other students
