SPECIFIC BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

Laney College requests approval to receive a sub-award from San Mateo County Community College District/Skyline College in the amount of \$280,000 to provide contract training in energy efficiency and other green technologies for dislocated workers from Alameda and San Mateo counties. The sub-award recognizes Laney’s regional and statewide leadership in developing and implementing green building technology education for employment in the emerging energy efficiency and renewable energy fields.

ITEM SUMMARY: *(PLEASE DISCUSS THIS ITEM)*

The San Mateo County Community College District/Skyline College received a \$1.9 million grant from the U.S. Department of Labor for Bay Area Clean Energy Careers. Laney College is designated to receive a \$280,000 sub-award from these funds to provide contract training for displaced workers in Alameda and San Mateo counties in the field of residential building energy efficiency, renewable energy, and related green technology fields.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

This sub-award leverages Laney’s outstanding educational leadership in the fields of residential energy efficiency, commercial energy efficiency, and renewable energy. Laney will partner with the Skyline College, College of Marin, the Alameda WIB, the San Mateo WIB, and other community partners to provide contract training for green sector jobs.
