

**PERALTA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 09/10-25 To Eliminate Certain Services & Related Layoff Notices**

At its regular meeting held on October 27, 2009, the Peralta Community College District hereby resolves the following:

**WHEREAS**, under the Principles for Sound Fiscal Management adopted by the Community College Board of Governors, Title 5, California Code of Regulations, §58311, each District shall be responsible for the ongoing fiscal stability of the District through the responsible stewardship of available resources; and

**WHEREAS**, the State fiscal crisis has had a devastating impact on the District's financial condition, including budget reductions of over \$12 million in the 2009/10 year; and

**WHEREAS**, such District-wide approaches to address the reduction of funding for General Fund positions will likely require significant reductions and/or discontinuance/elimination of current services; and

**WHEREAS**, such restructuring may result in a reduction in the number of General Fund positions within the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees complies with California Education Code §§88014 and 88127 in its deletion of affected positions, upon notice of the expiration of such categorical funds; and the District is required by California Education Code §88017 to notify affected classified incumbents no earlier than 45 calendar days prior to the effective date of lay-off.

**WHEREAS**, the following classified position allocations are hereby affected by lack of funds, effective December 12, 2009:



**RESOLUTION NO. 09/10-11 To Eliminate Certain Services & Related Layoff Notices**

At its regular meeting held on October 27, 2009, the Peralta Community College District hereby resolves the following:

**WHEREAS**, the Peralta Community College District Board of Trustees approves acceptance and utilization of categorical monies from various Federal and State sources to fund certain classified positions in the District for specified periods of time, subject to renewal; and

**WHEREAS**, under the Principles for Sound Fiscal Management adopted by the Community College Board of Governors, Title 5, California Code of Regulations, §58311, each District shall be responsible for the ongoing fiscal stability of the District through the responsible stewardship of available resources; and

**WHEREAS**, funding through the various categorical program(s) have been severely cut; and District-wide approaches to address the reduction of funding of categorical programs will likely require significant reductions and/or discontinuance/elimination of current services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees complies with California Education Code §§88014 and 88127 in its deletion of affected positions, upon notice of the expiration of such categorical funds; and the District is required by California Education Code 88017 to notify affected classified incumbents no earlier than 45 calendar days prior to the effective date of lay-off.


