

**PERALTA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES
RESOLUTION NO. 09/10 - 12 To Eliminate Certain Services & Related Layoff Notices**

At its regular meeting held on March 23, 2010, the Peralta Community College District hereby resolves the following:

WHEREAS, the Peralta Community College District Board of Trustees approves acceptance and utilization of categorical monies from various Federal and State sources to fund certain classified positions in the District for specified periods of time, subject to renewal; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees complies with California Education Code §§88005, 88117, and 88127 in its deletion of affected positions, upon notice of the expiration of such categorical funds; and

WHEREAS, categorical funding through the Child Care program(s) will have been severely cut and the District is required by California Education Code 88017 to notify affected classified incumbents no earlier than 45 calendar days prior to the effective date of lay-off.

WHEREAS, the following classified position allocations are currently funded by the California Department of Education and the California State Chancellor's Office and are hereby affected by severe cuts in its budget, effective July 1, 2010:

Child Care Assistant II (10 mo)	5.00	Educational Services/Child Care
Clerical Assistant II/Typing (11 mo)	1.00	Educational Services/Child Care
Cook	0.75	Educational Services/Child Care
Coordinator/Children's Center	1.00	Educational Services/Child Care

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Chancellor is directed to:

1. Immediately notify all affected employee organizations of the issues, directions and concerns set for the in this Resolution, in order to allow any affected organization to request to meet and negotiate any resulting affects of lay-off.
2. Comply with all applicable sections of the California Education Code in preparing any and all required lay-off and/or reassignment notices to classified incumbents so affected by lack of funding, and any and all notices as required by collective bargaining agreement.


