

DECLARATION OF ELIHU M. HARRIS IN LIEU OF RESOLUTION RE AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, CHILD DEVELOPMENT DIVISION, FOR CHILD DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FOR 2010-2011

Authorization was requested of the Board of Trustees, for the Peralta Community College District at the regular meeting of the Peralta Board of Trustees on June 22, 2010, to enter into the 2010-2011 Child Development Contact Agreement with State Department of Education, Child Development Division, for Child Development Services at the Children Centers of College of Alameda, Laney and Merritt Colleges with a Maximum Reimbursable Amount (MRA) of \$910,300;
