Labor Fest 2012 and Berkeley City College will host “Tous-Ensemble! From Factory Occupation to the Streets” at 7 p.m., Wed., July 27 in the college’s auditorium, 2050 Center St., in Berkeley. Workers in Europe have come under increasing attack by their employers and the state. Workers have started to forge links across industry and union lines to unite and generalize their struggles. Two participants in these struggles, one a CGT union militant at Renault Guyancourt, a technical center of 12,000 workers, the other a militant of the French left group, Fraction “Étincelle” of Lutte Ouvrière – will talk about their experiences and show short video clips of some of the struggles. □ The event is co-sponsored by Berkeley City College’s Global Studies Program and Club, and is free and open to the public.
