ITEM TITLE:

Consider Approval of Resolution 11/12-21, Accept Bid and Award Contract, District-Wide Security Surveillance Project, Increment 2 (Bid No. 11-12/09), to Central Sierra Electric Company Inc.

SPECIFIC BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval is requested of Resolution 11/12-21, to accept the bid and award a contract for the District-Wide Security Surveillance Project, Increment 2 (Bid No. 11-12/09), to Central Sierra Electric Company Inc., in the amount of \$5,282,849.

ITEM SUMMARY:

A formal bid was conducted for this project (Bid No. 11-12/09), and a bid opening was held on November 3, 2011. Three bids were received, as follows:

The lowest responsible and responsive bid was submitted by Central Sierra Electric Company Inc., in the amount of \$5,282,849. This resolution formally accepts the bid and authorizes the contract award to Central Sierra Electric Company Inc. for the District-Wide Security Surveillance Project, Increment 2 (Bid No. 10-11/09).

SOURCE OF FUNDS (AND FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT):

Bond Measures E (30%) and Measure A (70%), as approved by the voters in Peralta's constituency and authorized under Resolution 05/06-45, Exhibit A-1, District-Wide Project, "District-wide safety systems including disaster preparedness, campus security and hazardous and toxic waste handling."

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

Bid information for this project was published in newspapers of general circulation and ethnic publications reflecting the diversity of the market area. Bid information was sent to all Chambers of Commerce within the market area to disseminate to their constituency, local plan rooms and associated contractor subscription services. A total of 461 new digital cameras and 102 existing analog and digital units will be integrated in this project.

DELIVERABLES/SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope of work for this project includes, but is not limited to:

- Installation of a total of 461 surveillance cameras to be located at each campus and District Administrative Complex exterior locations

- Interior surveillance cameras in smart classrooms and other interior areas at each campus
- Associated cabling and electrical installation
- Integration of existing analog and digital cameras (102 existing cameras)
- Installation and configuration of a new IT infrastructure including wireless access points
- Signage at designated areas
- Coordination and integration of Increment 2 with Increment 1 at the District Sheriff's Office Command Center for monitoring 24/7

ANTICIPATED COMPLETION DATE:

Project is estimated to be completed seven months from Notice to Proceed.

DISTRICT-WIDE SECURITY SURVEILLANCE PROJECT, INCREMENT 2
BID NO. 11-12/09**

CENTRAL SIERRA ELECTRIC COMPANY INC.

WHEREAS, this Board has heretofore advertised for bids to secure all labor, material, equipment, mechanical workmanship, transportation and services for the District-Wide Security Surveillance Project, Increment 2 (Bid No. 11-12/09); and

WHEREAS, three bids were received in response to said advertisement on the 3rd day of November, 2011; and

WHEREAS, this Board does hereby accept the bid of Central Sierra Electric Company Inc.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board does hereby accept the bid of Central Sierra Electric Company Inc., P.O. Box 698, Jackson, California 95642, for Total Bid in the amount of FIVE MILLION TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-NINE AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$5,282,849.00); making the total contract price FIVE MILLION TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-NINE AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$5,282,849.00); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the bid of the other bidders shall be and the same are hereby rejected; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of this Board be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in accordance with law with said Central Sierra Electric Company Inc. for the District-Wide Security Surveillance Project, Increment 2 (Bid No. 11-12/09), and the bid bond of said bidder be returned to it upon the acceptance of said contract together with the bonds attached thereto.
