Consider Approval of a Resolution Granting Authority for an Extension of the Clean Energy Grant between the California EDD and Laney College.

ITEM SUMMARY: *(PLEASE DISCUSS THIS ITEM)*

Requesting Board consideration of a Resolution Granting Authority for an Extension of the Clean Energy Grant between the California EDD and Laney College. The prior EDD Clean Energy Grant was \$1,000,000, extending the grant will bring additional funding in the amount of \$230,400 to the Laney College Green Jobs Program.

SOURCE OF FUNDS (AND FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT):

Funding Source: Federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds via an extension of the California EDD Clean Energy Act Grant, categorical funds, with no fiscal impact on Peralta.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

The proposed grant extension will allow the Laney Green Jobs Training Program to provide graduates of our Clean Energy Grant Training Cohorts with On-the-Job Training opportunities. As we are current recipients of nearly half a million dollars in WIA funding via the EDD Green Jobs Grant, timely acceptance and delivery of services under this EDD extension of ARRA funding is critical as well as beneficial to our Clean Energy Grant program graduates.

DELIVERABLES/SCOPE OF WORK:

The EDD Clean Energy Grant Extension would provide funding to the Laney Green Jobs Program to support the development and administration of an On-the-Job Training program for graduates of the EDD Clean Energy Grant funded cohorts. In return for the EED Grant extension funding, the Laney Green Jobs Program will provide:

- OJT outreach to locate interested EDD Clean Energy Grant funded graduates as well as employers
- Assessment of interested graduates for areas of job-skill-development needed
- Screening of employers for OJT interest, capabilities, and capacity
- Placement of graduates with employers for OJT
- Case management for all graduates placed with OJT employers
- Reimbursement to employers providing OJT to graduates, up to 80% of wages paid
- Administrative support and grant management
- State and federally mandated reporting.
