ITEM TITLE:

Green Diesel Technology Earmark from the City of Berkeley for the College of Alameda

SPECIFIC BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

Consider Approval of the Green Technology Earmark from the City of Berkeley for the College of Alameda ATLAS Program

ITEM SUMMARY:

The key objective of the East Bay Green Jobs Project is to manage and implement education and job training programs to teach applicable skills in the energy efficiency, alternative energy, clean technology and other emerging green industry sectors through the College of Alameda ATLAS program. This project will serve Berkeley, Oakland, Richmond and Emeryville residents.

SOURCE OF FUNDS (AND FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT):

Funded by the City of Berkeley not to exceed \$80,000.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

The earmark is to introduce students to Green Diesel technology skills, including: periodic smoke inspection, compressed natural gas (CNG), engine service and diesel particulate filter(DPF) technology inspection and service; and to train students for the position of entry level Preventive Maintenance Technician (PMI).

DELIVERABLES AND SCOPE OF WORK:

College of Alameda will purchase hands on training materials such as diesel engine parts, testing equipment, and welding materials. Three courses will be funded by this earmark:

1. A Preventive Maintenance Inspection 12 week course will be taught covering clutch adjustment, cooling systems, battery load testing, brake adjustments, and air brake maintenance.
2. A 5 week preparatory California Class A Driver's License course,
3. Auto Body 12 (Auto Body Welding)
