ITEM TITLE:

Application by the Laney College Career and Technical Education Division and the Laney College Green Jobs Training Programs to the Economic and Workforce Development Program of the Chancellor's Office of California Community Colleges for Job Development Incentive Funding.

SPECIFIC BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

Consider approval of application to Chancellor's Office of California Community Colleges for Economic and Workforce Development Program funds, specifically the Job Development Incentive Funding, for the Laney College Career and Technical Education Division and the Laney College Green Jobs Training Programs.

ITEM SUMMARY:

Laney College seeks approval of an application to the Chancellor's Office of California Community Colleges' Economic and Workforce Development Program funding, specifically the Job Development Incentive Funding, for the Career and Technical Education Division and the Green Jobs Training Programs to provide solar and energy efficiency training as well as wrap-around student services, professional/entrepreneurial development, and job placement.

SOURCE OF FUNDS:

All funding from the Chancellor's Office of California Community Colleges' Economic and Workforce Development Program funds, specifically Job Development Incentive Funding, with all required match from already-granted federal Department of Labor funding currently administered via EDD and the Oakland Workforce Investment Board. Not to exceed \$330,000.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:

This program is designed especially to provide support for job development activities within the clean energy sector for graduates of Laney's clean energy programs.

DELIVERABLES AND SCOPE OF WORK:

Provide hand-on training of unemployed, underemployed, and incumbent workers in Solar Photovoltaic Design, Installation, and Sales, Energy Efficiency Sales and Auditing, and national Building Performance Institute (BPI) as well as North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners (NABCEP) testing and certification within Laney College's Environmental Contract Technology and Electric and Electrical Technology Departments. Training will be enhanced by wrap-around student services and case management as well as on-going professional/entrepreneurial development and post-training job placement support via the Laney College Green Jobs Training Program.
