

Policy 6.45 Enrollment Fee, Financial Assistance, and Deferred Payment Policy

The Education Code of the State of California mandates that each district governing board shall charge each student a fee for enrolling in credit courses. Pursuant to the requirements of the Education Code, the following enrollment fee policy has been adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Peralta Community College District.

All students are required to pay the California Community College enrollment fee, as established by the State. Each College of the Peralta Community College District shall grant enrollment fee waivers, Board of Governors grants, and enrollment fee credits to all students who are eligible and who apply for this assistance.

A. Time of Charges:

The enrollment fee shall be paid at the time the student is enrolled in class. Each College will provide a deferred payment plan to assist any student who is eligible under District-approved rules and regulations.

B. Financial Assistance Awards

The Peralta Community College District Board of Trustees may grant enrollment fee waivers and enrollment fee credits.

The Board of Trustees shall implement Board of Governors fee waivers to students who are eligible and who apply for this assistance.

C. Deferred Payment Plan

Each College shall provide a deferred payment plan to assist any student who is eligible under District-approved rules and regulations.
