

■ Active Students (719 Total) ■ New students for Fall 2013 (141 Total)




New International Student Applications/Enrollment




■ Applications Received ■ New International Student Enrollment



Non Resident FTES (Fall 2008 – Fall 2013)






BCC - Active International Students by Country (311 total)




COA - Active International Students by Country (95 total)

- **F-1 Employment on Campus**
 - F-1 students are permitted to work part-time on the premises of the District/College that issued their currently valid I-20
- **F-1 Employment Off Campus**
 - Economic Hardship
 - Optional Practical Training (OPT)
 - Curricular Practical Training (CPT)

Employment is part of F-1 **student status** and **not a work visa**
