


East Bay I-80 Corridor Career Pathways Consortium

Proposal Development Process

In response to the California Department of Education (CDE) and the California Community College Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) Request for Applications (RFA) for the [Career Pathways Trust \(CPT\) grant funds](#), 11 school districts and 3 community college districts along the I-80 Corridor in the East Bay region are proposing to form a Consortium. These districts and colleges include:

- Cal State East Bay and UC Berkeley are included as other post-secondary partners




Proposal Development Process

To ensure that all of the East Bay I-80 Regional Consortium Partners can participate fully in the development of the Consortium's CPT proposal development process, the following three vehicles for participation are proposed:

1. **Executive Steering Committee:** Comprised of District Superintendents, College Presidents, Community College District Chancellors/Vice Chancellors and other strategic partners. This group is the decision-making body of the Consortium. The Work Group will report its progress to this Committee.
2. **Work Group:** This is the group that represents districts and partners prepared to engage at a high level, including implementing multiple pathways for a large percentage of students. The Work Group currently consists of Hayward, Berkeley, WCCC, OUSD, SLZUSD, ACOE, Peralta CCD, Contra Costa College, Chabot College, Cal State East Bay, Oakland WIB, Alameda County WIB, UC Berkeley, CCASN, and Career Ladders. It will work with the grant writer and our East Bay I-680 partners to conceive of and write the proposal. It will also involve industry partners and Industry Deputy Sector Navigators.

3. **Stakeholder Group:** All levels of participation are represented, including K-12, community college, and business. Executive Steering Committee, Work Group, and all others invested in participating attend. The purpose of this group is to report out from work sessions and align the work of the Consortium members.
