

## **Peralta Community College District – Other Bills of Interest**

**AB 13 (Conway) – Requires community colleges, CSU and UC to adopt policies regarding tuition rates for eligible veterans and their dependents to ensure conformance with newly adopted federal law regarding providing resident tuition for veterans and service people: *Signed by Governor***

**AB 548 (Salas) – Authorize continuation of multi-criteria screening process in nursing: *Signed by Governor***

**AB 675 (Fong) – Allows a community college faculty member to count a leave of absence under specified conditions to his or her second, third or fourth contract year: *Signed by Governor***

**AB 1606 (Chávez) – Authorizes CCC faculty and staff to use up to 30 days of leave for if they have those days available for maternity/bonding time: *Signed by Governor***

**AB 1906 (Wilk) – Authorizes community colleges to charge for share of wear on facilities or grounds rented by outside groups: *Signed by Governor***

**AB 1927 (Frazier) - would have require the BOG to adopt policies to be used for negotiating contracts between community colleges and banks and other financial institutions to disburse a student's financial aid award and other refunds onto a debit card, prepaid card, or preloaded card: *Vetoed by Governor***

**AB 1942 (Bonta) – Requires the BOG to review accreditation status of a community college in determining if it meets minimum conditions to receive apportionment funding and requires the accrediting community to report on policies and negative accreditation status of community colleges: *Signed by Governor***

**AB 1976 (Quirk-Silva) – Provides flexibility to increase number of Cal Grant B awards: *Vetoed by Governor***

**AB 2000 (Gomez) - provides that a student's exemption from nonresident tuition for an academic year pursuant to AB 540 is determined either by high school attendance in California for 3 or more years or by attainment of high school credits equivalent to 3 or more years of full-time high school coursework at a California high school: *Signed by Governor.***

**AB 2087 (Ammiano) – Requires the appointment of a CCC special trustee to include specified benchmarks to indicate the local capacity to run the CC: *Signed by Governor***

**AB 2295 (Ridley-Thomas) – Extends from one year to three years the time that a faculty member may transfer sick leave from one district to another: *Signed by Governor***

**AB 2507 (Bocanegra) – Would have made billing records when in connecting to pending litigation exempt from Public Records Act: *Failed Deadline***

**AB 2558 (Williams) – Recasts and updates professional development for faculty and staff: *Signed by Governor***

**AB 2705 (Williams) – Would have recast provisions of education code relating to renaming of part-time faculty: *Held in Senate Appropriations***

**SB 173 (Liu) – Requires reciprocity process for noncredit and adult education faculty to be developed and provide for process for evaluating adult education/noncredit need: *Signed by Governor***

**SB 174 (de León) – Increases the Cal Grant B access award through funding generated by SB 798: *Signed by Governor***

**SB 798 (de León) – Creates a tax credit to fund increase in Cal Grant B access award pursuant to SB 174: *Signed by Governor***

**SB 845 (Correa) – Requires the BOG to establish model contracts for districts entering into agreements with student financial aid cards: *Signed by Governor***

**SB 965 (Leno) – Stabilization funding for City College of San Francisco: *Included in Budget***

**SB 967 (de León) – Creates campus sexual assault requirements: *Signed by Governor***

**SB 1023 (Liu) – Authorize CCCO to enter into agreement with up to 10 CCDs to establish enhanced funding opportunities for foster youth: *Signed by Governor***

**SB 1196 (Liu) – Require development of statewide goals and local accountability and reporting requirements: *Held in Assembly Appropriations, provisions of bill included in budget trailer bill***

**SB 1425 (Block) – Require all districts to have a degree audit system and perform a degree audit back 3 years: *Held in Assembly Appropriations***
