Alameda County Workforce Investment Board (ACWIB) One-Stop Career Centers Contract for PCCD.

SPECIFIC BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

Consider Approval to accept the Alameda County Workforce Investment Board (ACWIB) One-Stop Career Centers contract with PCCD to operate the Alameda and North Cities One Stop Career Centers.

ITEM SUMMARY:

Consider approval of the Alameda County Workforce Investment Board One-Stop Career Centers contract with PCCD not to exceed \$800,000 through June 30, 2016.

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunities Act (WIOA) defines the nation's job training system and provides guidance for local workforce investment systems designed to increase the employment, retention and earnings of participants, and increase occupational skill attainment by participants. All Board approved contracts are subject to final negotiation and execution by the Chancellor.

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS: Presenter:

College of Alameda is the host of the Alameda One-Stop Career Center, which started operations in March 1997 in cooperation with the city of Alameda and the Alameda Private Industry Council (now Workforce Investment Board) in order to meet the employment needs of residents and employers in the city of Alameda. In 2014, PCCD successfully bid on and obtained the contract to serve the Cities of Albany, Berkeley, Emeryville, and Piedmont, as well as the City of Alameda. In order to meet this expanded mission, the North Cities One Stop Career Center located at the Berkeley Adult School was established in November 2014. The Alameda and North Cities One-Stop Career Centers are part of EastBay Works, a network of employment services throughout Alameda and Contra Costa Counties.
