50% time Consultant for the Mobile Apps Consortium Coordination

POSITION DESCRIPTION

To serve as the Mobile Apps Consortium Coordinator and continue the work of the Consortium including: curriculum development, professional development, and industry engagement across all 14 college members.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

- 1) Mobile Apps consortium Coordinator will facilitate the project activities including the following on-going activities:
 - a) Building a multi-college Mobile Apps Consortium with the support from an Industry Mobile Apps Development Leadership Team (in collaboration with our ICT DSN's);
 - b) Engaging industry to advise, help develop, and continuously refine relevant curriculum and programs;
 - c) Working collaboratively across colleges to develop new Mobile Apps curriculum;
 - d) Providing more efficient professional development opportunities for faculty by aggregating (coordinating) the need for them across the region and increasing the number of externships for faculty via scaled industry engagement;
 - e) Organizing "Student Days/Fairs" to show case the work of our students with Industry participation and support;
 - f) Proving that the Consortium is an effective, results-oriented partner with industry such that industry would be interested in sustaining it over time.
- 2) Coordinate the build out a regional, industry-driven, consortium that is focused on creating a new career pathway within the larger, regional ICT career pathways.
- 3) Lead and coordinate the effort to create, align and sustain industry-relevant curriculum that does not yet exist to meet industry demand that is continuously evolving and changing.
- 4) Facilitate the effort of member colleges to elevate and align their work at the regional level on a regular basis and develop on-going infrastructure for continued curriculum improvements.
- 5) Facilitate by assisting member colleges who are adapting to and moving to adopting the new, statewide model curriculum for IT.
- 6) Assist member colleges in the application of the core courses of the IT Model Curriculum to serve as a foundation for the Mobile Apps Curriculum and as possible dual enrollment opportunities for high schools partners

PAYMENT LIMIT
